Hiệp hội các Trường Đại học Hàng hải Quốc tế (IAMU) được thành lập từ năm 1999, hiện có 63 trường, viện thành viên từ 35 quốc gia với mục đích xây dựng định hướng phát triển, hợp tác giữa các thành viên về đào tạo và huấn luyện hàng hải. Hàng năm IAMU đều tổ chức báo cáo, xuất bản các bài báo, dự án nghiên cứu mới tại Hội nghị thường niên của IAMU (Annual General Assembly - AGA). Năm 2017, Hội nghị thường niên lần thứ 18 sẽ được tổ chức tại Học viện Hải quân Nikola Vaptsarov (Bulgaria) từ ngày 11/10 - 15/10 với chủ đề "Triển vọng toàn cầu trong đào tạo và huấn luyện hàng hải: Hướng tới vận tải biển bền vững, xanh và tích hợp".

Trong khuôn khổ Hội nghị thường niên sẽ diễn ra Hội thảo khoa học dành cho các nhà nghiên cứu (gọi tắt là IAMUC) và Hội thảo dành cho sinh viên đến các trường thành viên (gọi tắt là IAMUS). IAMU khuyến khích các nhà khoa học và sinh viên thuộc các trường thành viên viêt bài cho kỷ yếu khoa học của IAMU AGA 2017 về các vấn đề sau:

Important deadlines

Prospective authors are cordially invited to submit up to one-page abstract before **31st March 2017**. After notification of acceptance (**1st May**) the authors will be asked to prepare a full paper version. The deadline for sending full paper versions, MS-Word using .doc or .docx file format, is **1st June 2017**. Accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings. The language of the papers is English.

Abstract

The abstract limit is one page but must contain at least 300 words. The abstract should explain clearly the content and relevance of the paper. Authors should submit their abstracts electronically to <u>lec@nvna.eu</u>. The abstract submission deadline is **31st March 2017**.

Submission of an abstract will be taken to imply that it represents original work and that it has not been previously published or considered elsewhere for publication. Notification of acceptance will be given to the corresponding author by 1st May 2017. Authors are invited to submit any questions lec@nvna.eu.

Full Paper

Authors of abstracts that are accepted for inclusion in AGA2017 will be asked to submit a full paper version. Authors are fully responsible for the content/originality of the paper and for the English language quality of the text. Therefore, we suggest before sending in your manuscript, the complete text of the manuscript to be checked or proof-read by an English language expert.

Submission

Submission should contain the manuscript and cover letter. Editable files (e.g. MS Word) are required to typeset a manuscript for final publication. At submission, authors can choose to have their full paper formally refereed as a means of improving its research status. Authors should submit their manuscripts together with the cover letter electronically to $\underline{lec@nvna.eu}$. The submission deadline is **1st June 2017**.

All correspondence, including notification on the submission decision and request for revision, is sent by e-mail.

Manuscript Text Formatting

The manuscript must contain the following essential elements:

The manuscript should contain: Title of the paper; Name, affiliation, and email of each author; Keywords (3-5 words); E-mail address and telephone/fax numbers of the corresponding author.

Title

Support: Author names, scientific/academic degrees and titles, affiliations (if available – name of the institution, postal address, the e-mail address of each author)

Abstract (maximum 500 words)

Keywords (maximum 6 keywords)

Main text (A4 page size, margins of 2.5 cm, Times Roman 12-point font, text fully justified, 1,5-line spacing)

Conclusion

Acknowledgements (acknowledgements should be collected in a separate section at the end of the manuscript before the references)

Reference list. All references mentioned in the Reference list should be cited in the text, and vice versa. References can be in any style or format as long as the style is consistent. However, references should contain: author(s) name(s), journal title/book title, chapter title/article title, year of publication, volume number/book chapter and the pagination must be present.

Manuscripts should be written in good English using either UK or US spelling. Authors are responsible for the accuracy of content. The length of the manuscript is limited to ten (10) pages including illustrations and tables. The preferred length is 8 pages.

Illustrations

As the Conference proceedings will be printed in black and white, it is the author's responsibility to ensure that all coloured illustrations (figures, photographs, graphs, images) are readable when translated to black and white in the printed proceedings. Illustrations should contain only English labels and be prepared in the final published size, not oversized or undersized. Illustrations can be placed either next to the relevant text in the manuscript, or on separate page(s) at the end. Each illustration should have a caption.

Graphics, figures, photographs and illustrations should be embedded in your digital file. In addition, where possible, all graphs, tables, photographs and illustrations should also be included as separate files. Images should have a resolution of at least 300 dpi.

Tables

Tables should be submitted as editable text and not as images. Tables can be placed either next to the relevant text in the manuscript, or on separate page(s) at the end. Tables should be numbered consecutively in accordance with their appearance in the text. Each table should have a caption.

Please use Times Roman as your font, 12-point font size and 1,5 line spaced. The title should be presented in 14-point. The title and author list should be presented centrally, while the paragraphs of the abstract should be justified. The presenting author's name should be underlined in the author list. A contact e-mail address of the corresponding author should be provided. References should be cited in the text and appeared on the bottom of the first page [1]. References can be in any style or format as long as the style is consistent.

Equations should be prepared using the equation editor in MS Word. Any equations that have to be displayed separately from the text should be numbered consecutively.

Cover Letter

A cover letter stating explicitly that the manuscript is being submitted for publication in the Conference proceedings must accompany the manuscript. In addition, the corresponding author should state if the manuscript is to be formally refereed.

Also, the cover letter should be included biography of the presenting author. The biography is limited to a maximum of 300 words.

Conference presentation and proceedings.

Regardless of whether submitted papers are formally refereed, all authors whose abstracts are considered suitable will have their papers included in AGA2017 conference and the printed proceedings. The papers will be checked to confirm their authenticity. The proceedings will be included in the index of scientific citation.

The conference program will be constructed on the received papers. The presentations might be only oral or oral with Power Point Presentation. The duration of the presentation has to be no more than 15 min. Since overall time for paper presentations at the conference is limited, it is possible that, due to time constraints, the abstracts that have been recommended for publication might not be included in the AGA2017 program for presentation.

Authors of IAMUS

IAMU Students (IAMUS) conference is a part of the IAMU AGA18 intended for students from IAMU member institutions to present their project work. It is an opportunity for students to participate in maritime education and training related activities, meet and exchange ideas with students from other institutions, meet different industry members and experience other cultures.

The students are invited to submit an abstract and a presentation describing their work. The IAMUS2017 will have a separate agenda from the AGA18. However, authors of the three best presentations will be invited to present their work once again at the main conference on the last day of AGA18. All other participants will be invited to attend the main conference and the conference dinner on the last day.

IAMUS2017 topics include, but not limited to:

- Maritime education and training (MET)
- Safety of navigation
- IT and modern technology in maritime studies
- Logistics and management
- Energy efficiency in maritime transport
- Human element
- Maritime English
- Culture and communication in maritime industry

Abstract

The abstract limit is one page but must contain no more than 300 words in English. The abstract should explain clearly the objectives, content and relevance of the presentation. The abstract should contain: (1) Title of the presentation, (2) Name, affiliation, and email of each author, (3) E-mail address and telephone/fax numbers of the corresponding author.

Authors should submit their abstracts electronically to $\underline{lec@nvna.eu}$. Authors are recommended to use either DOC (DOCX) or PDF as the file format. The abstract submission deadline is 1^{st} June 2017.

Submission of an abstract will be taken to imply that it represents an original work and that it has not been previously presented or considered elsewhere for publication. Notification of acceptance will be given to the corresponding author by 1st July 2017.

Authors are invited to submit any questions at lec@nvna.eu.

Full Paper

Authors of abstracts that are accepted for inclusion in IAMUS2017 will be asked to submit a full paper version. Students are fully responsible for the content/originality of the paper and for the English language quality of the text. Therefore, we suggest, before sending in your manuscript, the complete text of the manuscript to be checked or proof-read by an English language expert.

Submission should contain the manuscript and cover letter. Editable files (e.g. MS Word) are required to typeset a manuscript for final publication. The cover letter should include in a few

words what the topic of the paper is about and brief information on the presenting student (name, institution representing, class year and any other information deemed necessary by the author). Authors should submit their manuscripts together with the cover letter electronically to lec@nvna.eu. The submission deadline is **1st September 2017**.

All correspondence, including notification on the submission decision and request for revision, is sent by e-mail.

CRITERIA FOR PUBLICATION

- Papers should not exceed 6 standard pages, including visual material.
- The text should be typed in justify mode one-sided A4 format, Font: Times New Roman 12-points in Microsoft Word. The margins of each page should be: left 20 mm, right 20mm, top 20mm, bottom 20 mm., 1.5-line spacing
- A one page Bibliographic references should be added at the end of the paper. These references should include all the information for the article/book/journal being referenced (name, author, date of publishing...) and should be numbered. This page can be included in the page count, but it is not limited to be.
- References should be given as footnotes on the bottom of each page. Footnotes should include the number of the reference in the bibliographic references at the end of the paper and the page range within the article/book/journal being referenced.
- The numbers of the formulae should be given by numbers in brackets () to the left of the formulae for easier reference in the text.

The conference organizing body reserves the right not to publish articles which do not meet the requirements.

Presentation

Authors of abstracts that are accepted for inclusion in IAMUS2017 will be asked to submit a presentation electronically to lec@nvna.eu. Authors are recommended to use slide-based presentation in PPT (PPTX) format. The presentation submission deadline is 1st September 2017. As there is limited time to present work at the IAMUS2017, it is entirely possible that papers that have been accepted for publication will not be included in IAMUS2017 program due to time constraints.

Authors should adhere to the following instructions:

- Presentation time is limited to 15 minutes (5 minutes after presentation is reserved for discussion)
- Recommended font size is 26 36 for titles and 16 24 for body text
- Presentation should have a cover slide (including title, authors, conference name and date), body slides (describing the most important research/work information) and a conclusion slide (describing authors most important conclusions, thoughts and ideas)
- Authors are encouraged to use figures, graphs, tables and other graphic elements with no limitations.
